With its custom shop, Horotec wants to break the traditional codes of watchmaking tools. This custom shop, launched by Horotec, targets a watchmaking clientele who wants to use Swiss quality tools with a touch of originality. These are new, limited edition tools that this shop will offer. By chapter, we will find different accessories with original patterns, different colors and reinvented textures.

Founded in La Chaux-de-Fonds within this watchmaking heritage, it is with importance that Horotec will favor the knowhow of local craftsmen. With their knowledge and experience, they will contribute to revisiting watchmaking tools. Different techniques will be used to create these novelties. We can cite waterpainting, guillochage, engraving, electroplating etc.

By offering unique products, Horotec wishes to bring together watchmaking professionals and enthusiasts around an innovative concept, following current trends.

Initially, Horotec will take care of the customization of its products but will remain open to collaborate on projects, to receive ideas or to requests for customization.

It is essential to involve our craftsmen in the manufacturing method of these new products. These products are all authenticated **Swiss Made**, thus affirming the quality of what we have been offering for years.

The trend of personalization exists for many products. Several brands are developing in this direction. Thus, we decided to bring this possibility in the sector of watchmaking tools.

The products that will be offered on this shop will be **in limited quantities** in order to distinguish them from our traditional products. In addition, the time spent by our craftsmen on each product does not allow mass production. The tool's function does not change, but its visual identity and physical appearance do.

We select quality materials, which allow our tools to last over time. An edition as we propose it must be able to exist in the future as a messenger of Swiss know-how.

Traditions are being lost and so is manual work. We do not only want to distinguish ourselves but to promote these professions which are tending to disappear. These are the professions that have allowed watchmaking to reach its level of quality, losing them would be a terrible mistake. We want the customer to perceive the watchmaking tools offered on this shop differently, as a tool perpetuating a tradition.

This also allows us to show that craftsmanship is not only intended for the watch but can also be found in the tool that designs it.

Other products will appear over time. As indicated, the importance is to promote, through different chapters, the manual trades of our craftsmen.

Thus, the first chapter will deal with the art of waterpainting. On our Custom Shop, you will find explanations about this manual process and a video presenting the craftsman.

In each chapter, you will discover the products, the explanation of the artisanal process as well as a video presentation.

It is important to note that for each of the chapters, Horotec remains open to discuss possible customizations that use the artisanal process of customization.



With the tools customized by Horotec, you will distinguish yourself from traditional watchmaking tools, you will show that you also attach importance to quality products which will be reflected in your work. Water painting:


Process using inks that resist the surface of water without mixing and that prints on the object that is dipped inside.
